2025 Thanksgiving Pie Pickup/Fundraiser FAQ

How do I enroll in the Delicious Orchards Pie Pickup/Fundraiser Program?

In August, an introductory email will be sent to anyone that has expressed interest in our Thanksgiving Pie Pickup. The primary contact for the 2024 Pie Pickup Participants will automatically receive an email.

If you would like to be added to the distribution list, please email fundraisers@deliciousorchardsnj.com with the following information:

- **Contact Name (preferably single point of contact)**

You will be included on the list of **POTENTIAL** pickup/fundraisers. Please contact us before the September deadline to ensure you receive our email and have sufficient time to review the requirements and critical dates for enrollment/order placement. Please be aware that our emails may land in your junk/spam folders.

When you receive the email, we suggest you reply to fundraisers@deliciousorchardsnj.com as soon as you have decided to enroll. Participation is **first come, first serve** and there will be a **LIMITED** number of openings available.

Friday – September 26 – Deadline to enroll in Pie Pickup

Friday – October 31 – Deadline to submit Final Order for Pies

What pie flavors are available for pickup and at what price?

Our pies weigh approximately 2lb, are 9-inches in diameter and placed in individual 9" X 9" pie boxes. Distribution will be made in Master Cases which hold 10 pies of a single flavor.

(Dimensions are 19 ¾" L X 10" W X 13" H.)

Available flavors: APPLE, CHERRY, PUMPKIN and PECAN at \$18.99 per pie.

Flavors must be ordered in multiples of TEN as 10 fits in a Master Case.

The minimum total per order is 20.

Orders fewer than 20 can be picked up at the store.

For orders greater than **500** please contact us at fundraisers@deliciousorchardsnj.com as early as possible.

What is the deadline for Pie Orders?

Completed forms should be emailed to fundraisers@deliciousorchardsnj.com as soon as your FINAL numbers are available. No changes can be made once the form is submitted. The deadline for all Pie Orders is **Friday, October 31 at 4PM.**

Note that the order will be accepted only if you have previously received an email notification confirming your enrollment in the Delicious Orchards Pickup/Fundraiser Program.

Do you provide brochures or flyers to promote the sale?

We do not supply promotional material; each fundraiser group creates their own.

What should the fundraiser charge?

There is no standard rate, but we recommend a range between \$22 to \$25 for pies.

Where do we pick up the pies?

***** If there are more than 50 pies**, pickup is located at our **Mail Order Warehouse**
315 Route 537 East, Colts Neck, NJ 07722 adjacent to Eastmont Orchards.

***** If there are 50 or fewer pies**, pickup is located at our **Delicious Orchards Retail Store**
320 Route 34 South, Colts Neck, NJ 07722

When can we pay & pick up the pies?

Pie Pickup will be available on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday prior to Thanksgiving from 8AM to 3PM. (November 24-25-26, 2025)

On the order form, there is a spot to request for preferred date and time. We will do our best to assign the date and time as close as possible to what was requested.

When the order is placed in the system, we will email a copy of the final order with assigned pickup date and time.

Payment is preferred at time of pickup. Cash, Credit/Debit Card or Checks are preferred. All major credit cards are accepted. No gift cards, please.

Checks should be made out to Delicious Orchards for the exact amount of the order.

What takes place on Pie Pickup Days?

1. Each pickup representative must arrive at the assigned day and time with a copy of the invoice, emailed to him/her when the final order is placed. Anyone arriving early will be asked to wait until their assigned timeslot. Please be sure your vehicles are emptied out and clear of anything that could limit space or damage the pie cases. Depending on the vehicle, the cases can be double stacked. If you are bringing multiple vehicles, please pull up one at a time to provide our forklift sufficient room to bring the order to your trunk.

IMPORTANT: Please be mindful of weather conditions on pickup day.

In the event of wind and rain/snow, please be prepared with appropriate supplies such as heavy plastic, tarps, straps, bungee cords, etc. to help you protect and secure the boxes, thereby preventing damage and loss.

We will not have these accessories available.

2. Full payment will be made with **Cash, Check or Credit/Debit Card.**
3. Your order will be brought to your vehicle(s) in Master Cases of 10 pies.
DO personnel and pickup representative will **jointly** count the Master Cases for each pie flavor.

The pickup representative will be asked to sign off on the order, confirming that he/she will be leaving with a full and accurate order. Once the representative leaves our premises, Delicious Orchards is no longer responsible for perceived differences of flavors/quantity and will not make any adjustments.

Do pies need to be refrigerated after pickup?

Since pies are baked with no preservatives, we recommend refrigeration or at least stored in a cool location. Freezer bags will be available at the Pickup Location on request.

Why can't I order a partial box of a single flavor (fewer than 10)?

We have experienced that working with full boxes of a single flavor facilitates accuracy, i.e. pie count at pick up, correct distribution to multiple sites, etc.

Mixed boxes have been problematic especially when loading multiple vehicles.

What ingredients are used in your pies?

A-O APPLE #500: APPLES, SUGAR, CINNAMON, NUTMEG & BUTTER

CHERRY #503: CHERRIES (TART), CORNSTARCH & WATER

PECAN #509: EGGS, BUTTER, SUGAR, CORN SYRUP (DARK), CARAMEL FLAVOR,
SALT & SODIUM BENZOATE, VANILLA, SALT, & PECANS

PUMPKIN #510: PUMPKIN, MILK, SUGAR, EGGS, CINNAMON, SALT, ALLSPICE & GINGER

PIE CRUST BOTTOM: H&R FLOUR (UNBLEACHED WHEAT FLOUR), PALM OIL, WATER, SALT, CORN SYRUP
(DARK CORN SYRUP, CARAMEL FLAVOR, SALT SODIUM BENZOATE)

PIE CRUST TOP: H&R FLOUR (UNBLEACHED WHEAT FLOUR), PALM OIL, WATER & SALT

FLOUR INGREDIENTS: WHEAT FLOUR (UNBLEACHED), MALTED BARLEY FLOUR, NIACIN, IRON,
THIAMIN MONONITRATE, RIBOFLAVIN & FOLIC ACID
